DIRECTOR

Amber Foster has served as a missionary in Honduras for the last 15 years. She is the mother to 6 beautiful children and the Director of Breaking Chains Honduras, a ministry that serves primarily young adults living in at risk situations in Tegucigalpa. Her interest in MK Camp began when she volunteered in the kitchen 4 years ago while attending camp with her oldest daughter. Upon seeing the unique bonds formed between the missionary kids at camp she became passionate about seeing the camp continue to grow. Her years of experience working with children and her passion for Christian relationships help equip her for her role as Camp Director.

CO-DIRECTOR

David Logue has served as a missionary in Honduras for the last 11 years. He founded Mountain Top Ministries, a small boys' home for at-risk young men, in Santa Lucia. Currently, MTM is home to 9 remarkable young men, ages 8-22. David also volunteers with TORCH Missions by helping short term groups with building houses and ensuring their trip to Honduras is most productive. Summer camp was the highlight of his year growing up. His interest in MK Camp started after Amber returned from her trip 3 years ago. After his first summer co-directing, his passion for summer camp reignited and he is excited to see the camp grow.

YOUTH SPEAKER

Campers will be divided into two groups for the morning and evening learning sessions. The Youth Speaker will be responsible for preparing and delivering age appropriate material that follows the weeks theme for campers age 13-18. The speakers and camp leadership will work together to develop the theme for the week.

JUNIOR SPEAKER

Campers will be divided into two groups for the morning and evening learning sessions. The Junior Speaker will be responsible for preparing and delivering age appropriate material that follows the week's theme for campers age 8-12. The speakers and camp leadership will work together to develop the theme for the week.

CAMP COUNSELOR

Our counselors are the backbone of a successful camp experience. These year we are seeking 30 capable, energetic young adults (or young at heart) to lead our campers through the camp experience. There will be 2 counselors for each room, which will hold up to 8 campers of approximately the same age. Each room, paired with the same room of the opposite sex will serve as teams for the week. Campers and counselors will stay in their teams for most camp activities but will have time to interact with other campers in free times and group activity times. Counselors will be expected to lead daily devotionals with their campers, participate in all activities as a leader and mentor, and in many cases fill other roles around the camp during the day. If you have someone you would like to counsel with as a partner we will do our best to follow your preferences, but the ultimate decision will be up to the camp leadership team.

HEAD CHEF

Our head chef will work together with camp leadership to develop a menu that is nutritious, provides special "Gringo" treats, and also falls within our budget. They will also work with parents to meet as many special dietary needs as possible.

KITCHEN TEAM

We are seeking a team of 4 people to help support our head chef and carry out the daily menu, as well as share love and encouragement to our campers.

NURSE

We are seeking someone with a medical background, preferably a doctor or professional nurse to oversee medication and any non-emergency medical situation for everyone at camp.

WORSHIP LEADER

Our worship leader will work with camp leadership and speakers to develop a song list that is accessible and edifying to all ages and supports the weekly theme of camp.

WORSHIP TEAM

If you have a worship team experience we would love to add you to our worship team.

CRAFT LEADER

Our craft leader will work with camp leadership and speakers to develop craft activities that are age appropriate, memorable and help support the week's theme.

CRAFT TEAM

We are seeking 2 people to join our craft team and help with the execution of the craft plans made by the Craft leader. These crafts will help reinforce the theme of the week and act as visual reminders of what the campers have learned once they return home.

GAMES LEADER

We are seeking someone with a dynamic personality who is willing to develop a set of games that will reinforce the theme of the week and then along with their team, carry those games out. This person will also be responsible for the morning time large group games.

GAMES TEAM

We are seeking 2 people to join our games team and help with the execution of the game plans made by the Games leader. These games will help reinforce the theme of the week and provide learning opportunities for our kinesthetic learners.

LIFEGUARD

We are seeking 2 trained life guards to oversee pool time each afternoon and ensure the safety of our campers while in the swimming pool.

PHOTOGRAPHER

In order to truly capture the moments our campers experience during the week we are seeking a professional photographer who is willing to get a little dirty alongside our campers. The photos taken during the week will be made available to campers families and privacy requests will be followed.
