

Coming From SPS:

Go through the toll booth leaving San Pedro Sula on CA5 heading south. PASS (do not turn onto) the turnoff to La Entrada. You will go over an old iron truss bridge... from this point your next turn is approximately 37 kilometers.

Take a right turn (after the 37 kilometers) at the sign marked "Pena Blanca" and "San Buenaventura"

From that turn the camp is approximately 21 kilometers away. On the way to camp you will drive through Rio Lindo and San Buenaventura.

The camp is on the left side, in the middle of a very curvy/snake like part of the road. The name of the camp, Campamento Jerusalen, is on the sign, along with a poster we plan to tape on it that will say "MK".

If you get to Pena Blanca you've gone approximately 1.5 kilometers too far.

Coming From Tegucigalpa and Siguatepeque:

Going north on CA5, PASS (do not turn onto) the turnoff to La Esperanza in Siguatepeque. From that point you will travel 38 kilometers and then PASS (do not turn onto) the turn off to Santa Barbara. Right after you PASS that turn off you will start seeing Lake Yojoa on the left hand side of the road.

Continue on CA5 for approximately another 14 kilometers, to the turnoff to Pena Blanca, where you will make a left turn. This turn is approximately at the point where you see the lake from highway CA5.

From the turn off, travel approximately 13.5 kilometers to Pena Blanca, and another 1.5 kilometers to the camp. The camp is on the right side in the middle of a very curvy/snake like part of the road. The name of the camp, Campamento Jerusalen, is on the sign, along with a poster we will tape on it that says "MK".
